NOTICE

In pursuance of Assam State School Education Board, Division – II, Notification No. ASSEB/DIV-II/R& A/PORT-NOTF/2026/53/2334 dated the 28th April, 2026 it is notified herewith for information of all concerned that all unsuccessful candidates of HS Final Examination, 2026, have to take re-admission as REGULAR STUDENT in HS 2nd Year and thereby they can be treated at par with regular candidate.

Accordingly, to execute the re-admission process and to ensure that the students meet the eligibility criteria to appear in the HS Final Examination, 2027, the following guidelines have been formulated by ASSEB DIV – II.

1. The unsuccessful students of the HS Final Examination from the year 2023 to 2026, as mentioned in point 3 below, have to take re-admission in HS 2nd Year. Such students have to opt for subjects as per subject combination given in Academic Regulation of ASSEB Div.- II issued vide No. – ASSEB/DIV-II/ COURSE CURRICULA/2025/007/558 dated 24/04/2025 since the HS Final Examination, 2027 will be held as per such subject combination with six compulsory subjects. In case of any difficulty in taking admission in the re-admission in the existing institution, the student will be able to take re-admission in any other institutions, as per convenience.
2. All the re-admitted students must have to compulsory appear in the Half Yearly Examination and Unit Test (as applicable) to become eligible as Regular Student for the HS Final Examination, 2027 provided., if the student does not want to take re-admission then he/she can enroll in Assam State Open School.
3. From 2027, a Special Examination will be conducted within two months the date of declaration of results of the main examination.
 - a) The students, who appeared in five subjects and declared failed in one subject or the students, who appeared in six subjects and declared failed in two subjects in the results of HS Final Examination, 2026, will have to appear in this Special Examination 2027, without taking fresh admission.
 - b) The passed students of HS Final Examination, 2026 and 2027 will get chance to re-appear for the betterment of the results in the Special Examination, 2027 for all the subjects, in which the candidate desire to appear.
4. From this year onwards, skill proficiency certificate shall be issued separately to all the students who have appeared in skill based subjects in the HS Final examination.
5. Earlier, there was ambiguity in the passing marks assigned to different subjects, as the criteria varied across disciplines and subjects. To address the lack of uniformity often led to confusion and perceptions of inconsistency and to establish a more transparent and equitable system, a standardized pattern has now been introduced. As such a student must have to appear in all the Six (6) subjects and securing of 33% of mark in aggregate is compulsory. However, if a student fails in one (1) Elective subject and gets pass mark in rest of the three (3) Elective subjects, he/she will be declared as pass. For certification passing in English and MIL/Alt. English is compulsory.

Further, as per ASSEB, Div-II notification no. ASEB/DIV-II/R& A/ PORT-NOTF/226/53/2346 dated 08/05/2026 eligible students will be submitting their applications online from 15/05/2026 to 24/05/2026 for re-admission to HS 2nd Year Class in different institution through the "SUJOG" re-admission portal. All students are advising to go through the prescribed guidelines/SOPs, important dates in detail for compliance and smooth conduct of the re-admission process.

GUIDELINES /SOP FOR STUDENTS:

SL. NO.	INSTRUCTION FOR STUDENTS
1	A Student has to submit application online through "SUJOG", re-admission portal
2	A student can apply up to maximum of three (3) nos. of applications.
3	To edit profile of a student, he/she can visit the PROFILE TAB in the student dashboard before preparation of selection list by the institution. The profile of a student can be edited only once.
4	The published Selection List and Waiting List for re-admission into H.S. 2 nd Year will be made available in the re-admission portal "SUJOG" for the students. The students will be notified of their selection through SMS.
5	After publication of selection list, students will be allowed to approve only one institution for re-admission using their login id in the portal. The student must take re-admission in the institution concerned within the stipulated time period to complete the re-admission process.
6	A student will be able to change their preferred Stream/Subject(s) at the time of re-admission. Students will be able to change their preferred Stream/Subject(s) at the time of re-admission as per the provision available in the portal and the institution concerned will have to update the same in the portal on the day of re-admission.
7	If a student does not accept the re-admission offer within stipulated time, the student will be removed from Selection List with information through SMS.
8	If a student does not apply/select any institution within stipulated time of opening of "SUJOG" re-admission portal, the student's name/profile will be disabled on the portal with information through SMS.
9	Mobile number should be unique for registration of student on "SUJOG" re-admission portal. Same mobile cannot be used of multiple applications.
10	Issuance of Gap permission certificate from ASSEB DIV – II, for re-admission into HS 2 nd Year Class has been discontinued students are advised to consult with institutions for their eligibility for re-admission.

- N.B.: - 1. Re-admission of the students whose mark-sheets are marked as "Compartmental" is not required.
2. The Re-Admitted students will attend class from 02/06/2026.
