

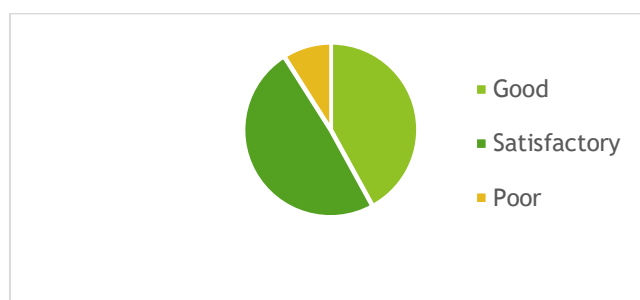
PARENTS/GUARDIAN FEEDBACK REPORT 2023-24

Parents play an important role in improving children's education. By providing valuable opinions and suggestions, they can help the College to improve its performance. Hence, the survey was undertaken from the parents/guardian of our students by distributing the questionnaire related to the course curriculum, activities, and improvement in student attendance as well as enhancing performance of the College.

A detailed report from the data so received after the necessary analysis has been presented below:

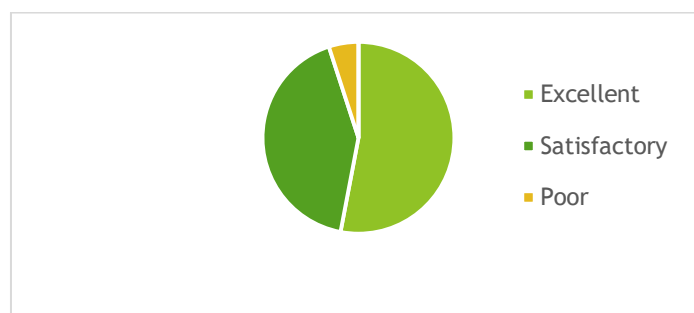
Parameter 1: How conducive is the college environment to the processes of teaching and learning?

Response: The survey conducted among 100 parents revealed the following opinions regarding the conduciveness of the college environment to the teaching and learning processes. 42 parents believe the college environment is conducive to teaching and learning. 49 parents expressed that the conduciveness of the college environment is satisfactory. 9 parents stated that the college environment is not conducive to teaching and learning.



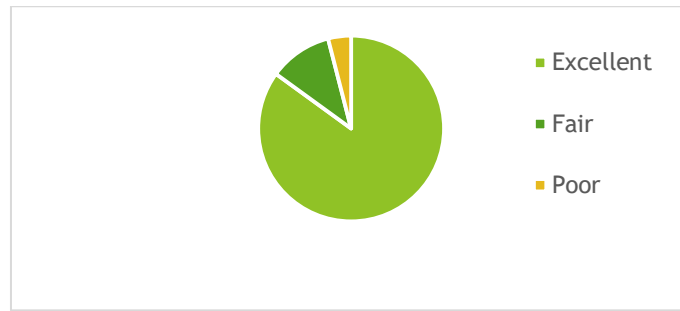
Parameter 2: How will you rate Cachar College as an institution for the study of stream/subject chosen by your son/daughter/ward?

Responses: The survey conducted among 100 parents provided the following ratings for Cachar College as an institution for the study of their ward's chosen stream or subject. 53 parents rated the institution as excellent. 42 parents were not satisfied with the institution. 5 parents rated the institution as poor.



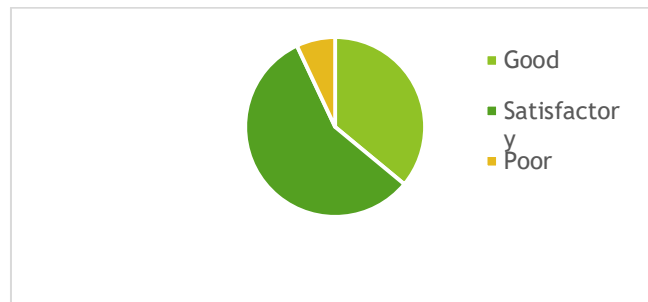
Parameter 3: Infrastructure of college according to you is

Responses: The majority of the parents stated that the infrastructure of the College is satisfactory and they even find it excellent.



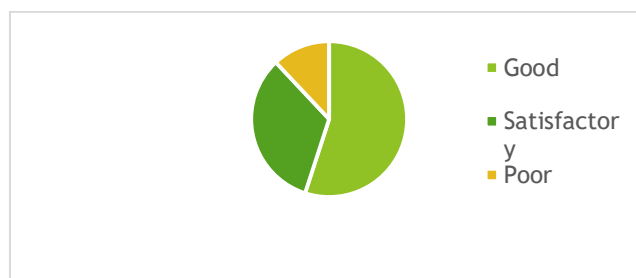
Parameter 4: Have you discovered a significant development of your ward's overall personality since she/he joined the college?

Responses: Out of 100 parents, 93 parents were satisfied with the performance and progress of their ward, 7 were not satisfied.



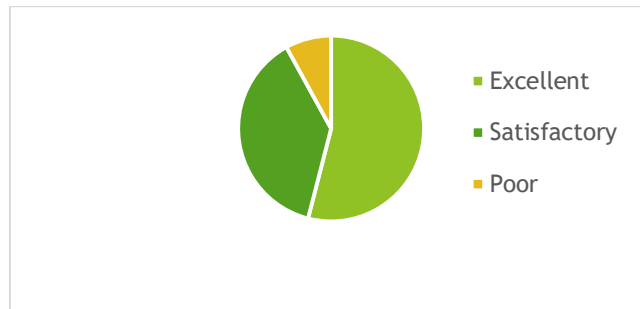
Parameter 5: Does the college have a satisfactory system of monitoring student's progress?

Responses: The survey conducted among 100 parents revealed the following opinions regarding the college's system of monitoring students' progress. 55 parents agreed that the college has a satisfactory system for monitoring students' progress. 33 parents rated the system as satisfactory. 12 parents disagreed, stating that the college does not have a satisfactory system for monitoring students' progress.



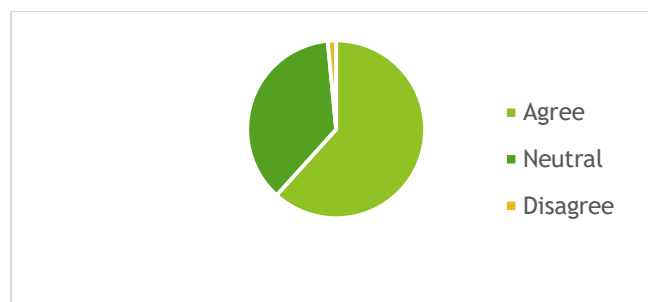
Parameter 6: What is your assessment of the learning resources provided by the college? (these would include facilities like library resource, availability of computers)

Responses: The survey conducted among 100 parents provided the following assessments of the learning resources offered by the college, including facilities such as library resources and computer availability. 58 parents assessed the learning resources as excellent. 34 parents assessed the learning resources as satisfactory. 8 parents assessed the learning resources as poor.



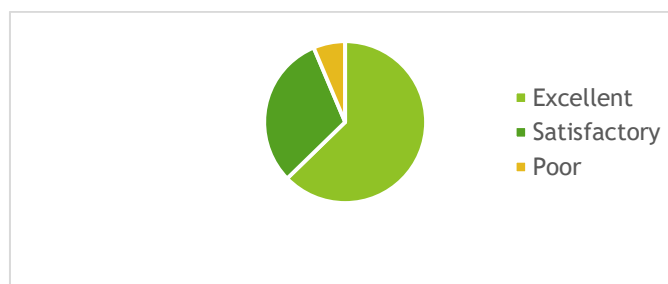
Parameter 7: Administrative staff in the institution is cooperative

Responses: The survey conducted among 100 parents revealed the following opinions regarding the cooperation of the administrative staff in the institution. 57 parents agreed that the administrative staff is cooperative. 34 parents were neutral about the cooperation of the administrative staff. 9 parents disagreed, stating that the administrative staff is not cooperative.



Parameter 8: Admission process of the college is

Responses: The survey conducted among 100 parents revealed the following opinions regarding the admission process of the college. 69 parents agreed that the admission process is excellent. 24 parents rated the admission process as satisfactory. 7 parents rated the admission process as poor.



Suggestions from Parents regarding improvement of overall quality of higher education in the institution:

- The overall quality of higher education in the institution is excellent.
- The college should focus on students and provide them notes and suggest them for their further future. As we are middle class we are dependent on college and not able to take any private tuition. So, it will be very helpful if the teachers provide them the needed notes in college and solve their doubts too.
- College needs to encourage Sports, And any other activities.
- There have been some issues with the behaviour of security guards.

Findings:

The analysis above reveals that a significant majority of parents express satisfaction with various aspects of the college, including its academic atmosphere, infrastructure, and their child's performance. They prioritize ensuring their child's attendance in classes and cite the availability of major academic subjects and the college's location as key factors in choosing this institution. However, some parents voice concerns about potential gaps in technical skill development and the adequacy of placement services. Additionally, there are suggestions for improvement, such as re designing the academic calendar in consultation with Assam University to ensure syllabus coverage within the corresponding semester. These insights provide valuable feedback for enhancing the overall experience and offerings of the college.
