This is for the information of all concerned that with an aim to catalyse academic development of students, Cachar College Mentoring Programme, 2020 (CCMP20), has been started in Cachar College for the academic year, 2020-21. The duration of the Mentoring Programme is three years for Degree Students. Mentoring Programme will involve (a) Mentoring Core (Principal as Principal Mentor, General Mentor (one), Stream Mentors (three) (b) Unit Mentors or *briefly* Mentors & Joint Mentors (if any) and (iii) Mentees.

Presently CCMP20 will involve newly enrolled students of TDC 1st Semester of the academic year 2020-21 only. To maximise contact hours for effective mentoring, teachers of a particular stream (Mentors) are selected for students of the same stream (Mentees). A notified group of Mentees and a Mentor with or without a Joint Mentor will form a Mentoring Unit. Mentoring Units are the Functional Units of the mentoring programme.

Each and every student, enrolled in Degree 1st Semester of 2020-21 will (i) note Mentor-Mentee Allocation Charts carefully, (ii) note the allotted Unit and Unit Mentor (teacher) (iii) contact the Unit Mentor, (iv) get registered as a Mentee in the Register, maintained by the concerned Unit Mentor and then (v) to follow instructions, as and when, given by the Mentor(s).

Esteemed teachers are requested to note their Mentoring Unit from the Mentor-Mentee Allocation Charts, CCMP20 and assume their role as Mentors. As a Mentee Unit may include both male and female students, a male/ female Mentor may nominate and take consent of another female/male Mentor/teacher as Joint Mentor, if available, to assist him/her, in case of any necessity and inform Stream Mentor and General Mentor accordingly. Mentors will maintain Register of Mentees under his/her command. track records of the Unit and keep liaison with the concerned Stream Mentor, General Mentor and Principal Mentor, as and when necessary.
